Admission Procedures
in Iraqi Universities

Introduction:

Considering the initiative to internationalize higher education in Iraq, announced by the Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research, the "Study in Iraq" program, this program provides scholarships funded by the Iraqi Government to international students of all nationalities and genders.

Achieving the fourth goal of the Sustainable Development Goals adopted by the United Nations, which stipulates that education is a right for every individual in society, the Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research in the Republic of Iraq, like other State's institutions, has rushed to assume its active role in the specialization of this Ministry, which is education, and launched applications for scholarships within the "Study in Iraq" program in its third version for the academic year 2025-2026, which provides fully funded scholarships with housing, an entry visa to Iraq with residency and health insurance fees at the undergraduate and postgraduate levels (Diploma, Bachelor's, Higher Diploma, Master's & Ph.D.) in Iraqi universities and in all specializations, the entity responsible for implementing the program is the Department of Studies for Arab and Foreign Students at Directorate of Scholarships and Cultural Relations.





The Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research has successfully established the “Study in Iraq” program and has attracted more than three thousand international students, the gateway to internationalization of higher education was opened thanks to the efforts of its specialized academic staff, as well as the Ministry has established common understandings between its universities and their foreign counterparts, facilitated exchanging of scholarships, study and research opportunities and brought international forums back to Baghdad.

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Part One

Chapter One:

First: Study Channels

① Free -Tuition Fees Scholarships:

It is intended as a day study grant that covers the following expenses: (study, accommodation, health insurance and entry visa to Iraq with study residency permit).

② Half-Free Tuition Fees Scholarships:

It covers **50%** of tuition fees paid with IQD or what is equivalent with USD for each academic year and scholarship covers costs such as (accommodation, health insurance, Iraq visa and residence permit).

③ Full Tuition Fees Scholarships :

It covers full tuition fees paid with IQD or what is equivalent with USD for each year and scholarship covers costs such as (accommodation, health insurance, Iraq visa and residence permit).

Second: General Principles of Admission: -

- ① Applicants must be foreigners or Arabs of non-Iraqi parentage, exclusively from foreign or non-Iraqi Arab origins.
- ② Neither the applicant nor their parents should hold Iraqi origin and must have acquired non-Iraqi nationality.
- ③ Neither the Applicant nor non-Iraqi origin and hold Iraqi nationality.
- ④ Applicant shall undertake not to promote a transaction to obtain Iraqi nationality while applying for scholarships within the program.
- ⑤ Applicant shall possess a non-Iraqi high school certificate, whether Arab or foreign.
- ⑥ Applicants must not have previously submitted an academic seat in any Iraqi public universities or private colleges and universities through approved admission programs exception of the applicants for postgraduate study.
- ⑦ Applicant must not be applying to one of the private or public admission programs in public universities or private colleges and universities.

Part One

- 8- Applicants who obtained an academic seat within the "Study in Iraq program" are not eligible for privileges such as appointment in Iraqi ministries or any other non-educational privileges.
- 9- Students in this program are not allowed to work (full-time or part-time) and the university or college sponsoring the student is not responsible.
- 10- It is not permissible to study different courses at the same time.
- 11- Evening bachelor's studies are not permitted, except for students with private expenses, who have the right to choose between day and evening.
- 12- Students applying for half- and full-tuition scholarships are not included in this discount and will not be transferred to the free tuition scholarship.
- 13- If the applicant is not admitted and meets the admission requirements for the free tuition scholarship program, he/she will be allowed to apply for the half -free tuition scholarship program or the full tuition scholarship.
- 14- A free scholarship is granted to undergraduate students (diploma and bachelor's) who have obtained a (very good) grade or above, or who are among the top ten, to study for a (higher diploma, Master's or Ph.D.) within the program.

Part One

- 15- A free scholarship is granted to postgraduate students (higher diploma and Master's) who have obtained a very good grade in the courses and an excellent grade in the discussion to study for a Ph.D. within the program.

Third: University Calendar

1- Admission Regulations to Free tuition Scholarships program: -

A) Undergraduate Study (Diploma/Bachelor)

- 1- The Applicant must meet the minimum requirements to guarantee admission to the university and college in which he/she wishes to study to obtain a bachelor's degree, according to the choices listed in the application form and according to the sequence of grades, as follows: -
 - 90% minimum average required to hold bachelor's degree in general medicine, 85% required to hold bachelor's degree in dentistry and pharmacy.
 - 65% minimum average required to hold bachelor's degree in full departments of Engineering specializations and nursing
 - 60% minimum average required to hold bachelor's degree in Other scientific and humanities specializations.
- 2- The applicant is excluded from the average requirement to obtain a diploma degree (institution after high school certificate).
- 3- The applicant who holds a technical or vocational diploma is exempted from the GPA requirement to obtain a bachelor's degree, according to the corresponding.
- 4- Medical group privileges are granted for an age not exceeding (25) years.
- 5- Other specializations privilege is granted for an age not exceeding (30) years.

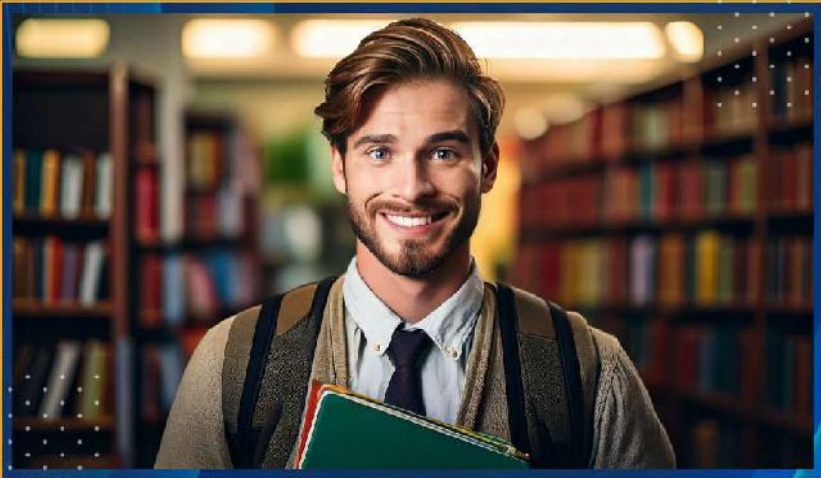
B) Postgraduate (High Diploma, Master' and Ph.D.)

- 1- The Applicant must meet the minimum requirements for guaranteed admission, as follows: -
 - **65%** minimum average required to hold Master' or High Diploma degree.
 - **75%** minimum average required to hold a Ph.D. degree.
- 2- Master' degree or what is equivalent privilege are granted for an age not exceeding **(45)** years and not exceeding **(50)** years for Ph.D. degree.

2- Admission Regulations to Half -free tuition Scholarships program: -



A) Undergraduate Study (Diploma/Bachelor)

- 1- The Applicant must meet the minimum requirements for guaranteed admission to the university and college in which he/she wishes to study to obtain a bachelor's degree, according to the choices listed in the application form and according to the sequence of grades, as follows: -
 - **80%** minimum average required to hold bachelor's degree in general medicine, **75%** required to obtain bachelor's degree in dentistry and pharmacy.
 - **60%** minimum average required to hold a Bachelor's degree in full departments of Engineering specializations and nursing
 - Without minimum average required to hold Bachelor's degree in Other scientific and humanities specializations.
- 2- Medical group privileges are granted for an age not exceeding **(30)** years.
- 3- Other specializations privileges are granted for an age not exceeding **(35)** years.

B) Postgraduate (High Diploma, Master' and Ph.D.)

- 1- The Applicant must meet the minimum requirements for guaranteed admission, as follows:-
 - **60%** minimum average required to hold Master' or High Diploma degree.
 - **65%** minimum average required to hold Ph.D. degree.
- 2- The applicant is exempt from the age requirement.



Part One

3- Admission Regulations to Full tuition Scholarships program:-

A) Undergraduate Study (Diploma/Bachelor)

- 1- The Applicant must meet the minimum requirements for guaranteed admission to the university and college in which he/she wishes to study to obtain a bachelor's degree, according to the choices listed in the application form and according to the sequence of grades, as follows: -
 - 75% minimum average required to hold bachelor's degree in general medicine, 70% required to hold Bachelor's degree in dentistry and pharmacy.
 - Without minimum average required to hold Bachelor's degree in full departments of Engineering specializations, nursing, scientific and humanities specializations.
- 2- The applicant is exempt from the age requirement.
- 3- The applicant will be able to choose university or college to apply.

B) Postgraduate (High Diploma, Master' and Ph.D.)

- 1- The applicant is exempt from the age requirement.
- 2- The applicant will be able to choose university or college his/ her specializations available to apply at free tuition and half- tuition scholarships for the concerns university.

Chapter Two

First: Submission Procedures:

- The student submits through the online platform "study in Iraq" in the link below:



studyiniraq.scrd-gate.gov.iq

- The student uploads copies of the required documents to the online platform.
- The student has the right to choose with maximum (5) universities in online platform (3 of them are for free tuition scholarship, one for half- free tuition scholarship and one for full tuition scholarship).
- After the initial nomination is issued for undergraduate and postgraduate scholarships, their files should be submitted by the students to technical committee represented for this purpose.
- In the case of the original file data of the student is proven correct the technical committee upload the documents for the purpose of collecting GPA and evaluate applicant's certificate.

Part One

- The scientific committee in government and private universities and colleges is responsible for conducting the Science education background of the applicant and making a decision to process the transferred credit and transit study materials.
- The student file admission can be viewed through online platform of "study in Iraq" by university or college that authorities for compliance the scientific background within transferred credits the platform against to that the college or university should be bear responsibility of their admission not corresponding to the admission procedures.
- In the case the original file data of the student is proven incorrect and the nomination will be cancelled.
- Admission for undergraduate and postgraduate studies at the college of education for women or science for women (only for women).



Part One

Second – A) Required Documents for Application

- 1- An original of high school qualification / secondary certificate (foreign or Arab) to apply for a bachelor's degree.
- 2- An original of high school qualification/ bachelor's certificate to apply for high diploma or Master's degree.
- 3- An original of bachelor's degree qualification/ Master' certificate to apply for Ph.D.
- 4- All the above-mentioned certificates must include a copy of transcript of mark of grades, be in color copies, translated into (Arabic and English), and duly certified by the Ministry of Education and Foreign Affairs in the country where the student is.
- 5- Submit with the required graduation documents the temporary or permanent equivalency certificate issued by the Iraqi Ministry of Education/General Directorate of Examinations, Evaluation of Certificates and Equivalency.
- 6- A copy of Master' certificate with (Pdf) form to obtain Ph.D. degree.

Part One

- 7- A copy of passport is valid for a period not less than six year.
- 8- One of the documents proving the student's origins with his parents: (the student's birth statement or the student's national identity card or nationality with the mother and father).
- 9- Personal photos must be taken against a plain white or off- white background, size (50*50mm) or (5*5 cm) ,no you can't wear tinted glasses or sunglasses for your photo.
- 10- A written pledge not to submit it to one of the study program inside Iraq, pledges that the information stated in the application form is correct and not obtaining Iraqi citizenship or submitting a naturalization application to grant Iraqi citizenship.
- 11- Document Required to a study board
 - Submit all original and certified documents referred to above with color copies
 - 2 personal photos
 - International health certificate is valid for more than 3 month.

Second - B - Entry Visa to Iraqi Territory & Study Residency

- 1- The Director General of Department of Scholarships and Cultural Relations conducted with public universities or private universities and colleges and interior ministries or whomever he/ she authorizes may grant an international student an entry visa to the territory of the Republic of Iraq and reside there for a period of one year renewable annually.
- 2- After the student obtains an entry visa, the Ministry of Interior sends a notification granting the visa to all border crossings and airports for the purpose of obtaining a normal entry visa.
- 3- The student must contact the university or college he is admitted 'into before purchasing travel tickets for the purpose of approving the granting of a visa to Iraqi territory after issuing a notification from the Ministry of Interior and specifying the airline company with confirmation of the issuance of the entry visa indicated at the airports and border crossings.
- 4- The student admitted 'into the program will be exempt from entry visa fees to Iraqi territory.
- 5- If the student wishes to bring his family, he must apply for a visa for them through the Iraqi embassy in the student's country.

Part One

Third: Nomination & Admission Mechanism

- 1- Universities present admission plans under the free and half -free tuition scholarships program. However, for study at private expense, admission will be according to the free and half -free tuition scholarship plan according to the specializations offered by public universities and private universities and colleges without specifying study seats.
- 2- The nomination of the applicant for scholarships is based on the options listed in the electronic application form. Submitting the electronic form is not binding for acceptance, as it is subject to the mechanism of competition and comparison in terms of choosing the university or college, specialization, and type of study program according to the principles in effect in the program.
- 3- The committee's decision to nominate the student is recorded in the electronic system by the specialization and type of study program by the person authorized to enter the electronic platform, the decision of rejection and non-nomination shall also be confirmed, with reasons stated.
- 4- The nomination shall be approved in the electronic system and the candidate's study seat shall be deducted from the plan of the Department of Scholarships and Cultural Relations.
- 5- The university or administrative order of acceptance is issued to the student whose nomination has been approved after the committee referred to above has reviewed the nomination minutes and the extent to which the candidate meets the controls and conditions required in this program.

Part One

- 6- Granting several study seats that are on the free scholarship program outside the academic controls after obtaining the approval of His Excellency, the Minister of Higher Education and Scientific Research or in accordance with the agreements in force within Arab and foreign countries.
- 7- The possibility of redistributing vacant seats in the plan to the specializations of applicants who meet the controls and conditions and whose nomination transactions have not been promoted to solid out the seats in their specializations, provided that the redistribution of those seats is within the study program and the required certificate and after obtaining the original approvals in this regard.
- 8- Universities determine the timings of Arabic language courses for students admitted 'into the initiative, as needed.
- 9- The university or college is the entity responsible for following up on the student's academic progress during the academic stages only.



Part One

Fourth: Cancel Admission, Postponement, Failure & Transfer

● Cancellation Admission

- a) Cancellation request can be raised by public and private universities and colleges in the case that the applicant uploads incorrect documents.
- b) In the case that the Applicant didn't communicate with technical members, his or her administration or universal order can be cancelled by the university or the college in a specific period to join the study.
- c) In the case that the terms and conditions for admission to study aren't proven.
- d) In the case that the applicant is willing to withdraw nomination and cancel admission for special circumstances.

● Postponement of enrollment:

- 1- After the applicant submits a written request, he/ she can postpone his/ her study in the case that he cannot join to study in the specific time to study and for specific reasons.
- 2- The Supreme Council of college has authority to address the delay of the applicant starting of the study and according to they saw suitable.
- 3- The admission of a new student to a college admitted into study (undergraduate and postgraduate) may be postponed for one year and otherwise his/her admission should be cancelled.

Part One

● Failure:

- a) An undergraduate student may fail for two years during his prescribed study period.
- b) The student must maintain a cumulative GPA of at least (65) in Master' degree and (70) in Ph.D. degree and succeed in more than half credits courses otherwise he/ she can be considered failed.

● Transfer:

- a) A student has been previously admitted ' may not be transferred from one university to another but otherwise in the cases submit real apologize prevent him/ her to complete his/ her study at university he/ she admitted ' in it in order to take the following procedures:-
 - 1- Transfer written request can be submitted and stated that the reason with their supporting documents if found.
 - 2- Conducting student interviews if the student starts studying and verifying the reason for the transfer.
 - 3- The approval of the Director General of the Department of Scholarships and Cultural Relations must be obtained then the university to which the student is admitted and the university to which he/she wishes to transfer must be contacted to.
- b) The university and college councils grant the authority to transfer a foreign student between the college departments and university faculties in which the student is admitted.

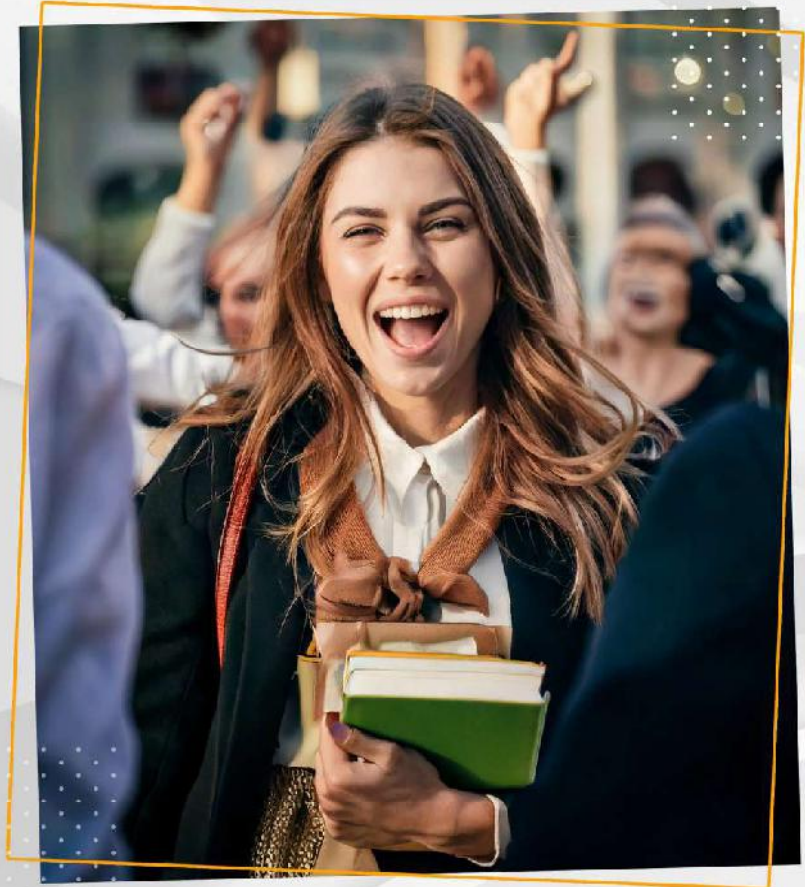

- For MA programs also provide an option for you to pay in two installments and BA for four installments.
- Those admitted into the two study channels (half- tuition fees and full tuition fees) cannot be exempted from paying tuition fees or reduced.

Chapter Two

Language of study: Study system in Iraqi universities

First: The approved language of instruction is Arabic, while medical specialties are taught in English.

Second: The educational system: The educational system in Iraqi universities consists of five different systems according to each university, college departments and educational stages, as shown below:

1- **Annual system:** It is a system whose duration is four years during which the student completes from 120 to 160 academic units that differ according to the scientific department in which the student is studying to obtain a bachelor's degree. The study depends on completing all the subjects of the academic year and the beginning of the academic year is with the beginning of the first semester specified according to the university calendar and the evaluation of students is only at the end of the academic year.

Advantages of the annual system

- Provided that the study materials are sufficient to cover each subject for two semesters.
- Not repeating approved assessments during the year in order to reduce pressure on the student

Disadvantages of the annual system

- Repeating the entire academic year if the student fails
- Comprehensive review and memorization of the study material in preparation for the final exams, which requires more effort.

Part Two

2- **Semester system:** It is a semester system that divides the academic year into two semesters, the first and the second, each of which lasts 15 weeks. The college holds two examination sessions annually, the dates of which are determined according to the university calendar, where the first session is at the end of the semester, the second session is at the end of the first semester, and the second session is at the end of the second semester of each year. The student studies the subjects of the first semester of the year and the subjects of the second semester in the second half of the academic year.

Advantages of semester system

- It is permissible to re-study the subjects in case of failure during the following semester without waiting for the new academic year.

Disadvantages of the semester system

- Completing the requirements of the academic subjects in a relatively short time, which puts a lot of pressure on the student and requires high and continuous concentration in a short period of time.



Part Two

3- **Course system:** It allows the student to choose the courses he wishes to study according to his desire from among those available during each level, and he can graduate based on completing a certain number of hours or academic units.

Advantage of Course System :-

- It gives the student great flexibility in choosing the study subjects according to his interests and abilities.
- Encourages independence and time management according to the student's needs.

Disadvantages of Course System:-

- It requires precise academic guidance to direct the student.

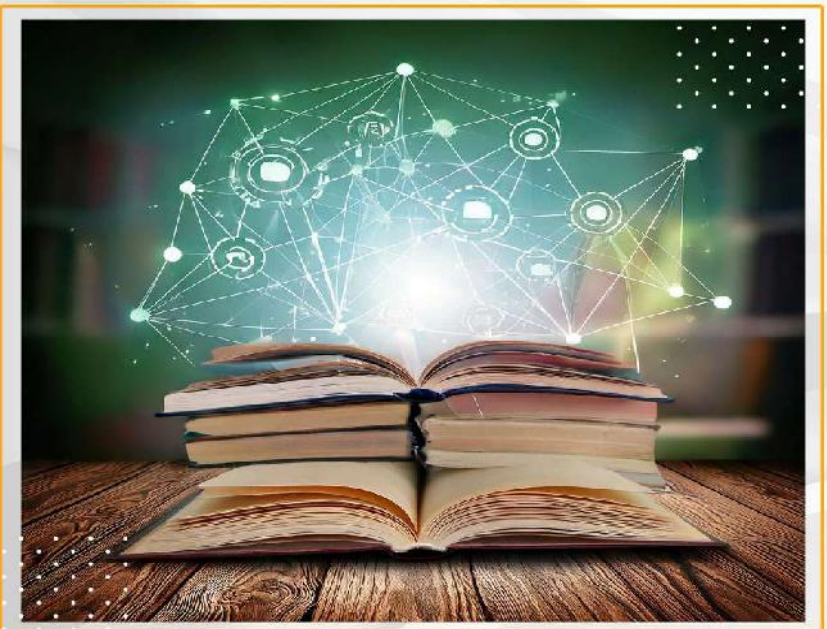
4- **Integration system:** It depends on integrating the study materials and linking them together so that the student studies integrated study units that cover multiple topics.

Advantage of integration system:

- Promotes critical thinking and encourages integrated understanding of material rather than memorization.
- The student gains comprehensive skills that go beyond a single subject.

Disadvantages of integration system:

- It requires the student to have high skills in organization and focusing on the links between different concepts.
- It may be difficult to understand for some students who prefer to study the subjects separately.



Part Two

5- **Bologna Process:** The semesters consist of two semesters, the first semester and the second semester, the actual study period in each semester is 15 weeks, excluding the exam period, the total number of study units for this system is approximately 240 study units for four levels, and each level of study has 60 study units, the start and end times of the semesters and exams are determined according to the university calendar, the unit system represents the basis of the track, as the student's effort is measured in units, and each subject or educational component has a number of units equivalent to the academic load required to pass it.

Advantages of Semester:

- The student has the right to choose the subjects he wishes to study.
- The grade is distributed over activities, practical aspects, and the final exam.
- The student can determine the duration of his study stages and can shorten them.

Disadvantages of Semester:

- Make a great effort to complete the academic requirements (theoretical + scientific) in a short time



Part Two

B-Postgraduate study system (higher diploma, Master's and Ph.D.)

- Iraqi universities rely on the (semester) system of courses with a thesis or dissertation as a graduation requirement, and the study period is as follows:-
- Higher Diploma: Not less than one calendar year and not more than two years.
- Higher professional diploma equivalent to a Master's degree, except for the academic title: not less than one calendar year and not more than two years.
- Higher diploma such as the diploma granted by (the Higher Institute of Accounting and Banking Studies) equivalent to a Master's degree with all privileges: not less than 2 calendar years and not more than
- Master's: two academic years including the Master's dissertation
- Ph.D.: Three years including thesis. dissertation

Note:

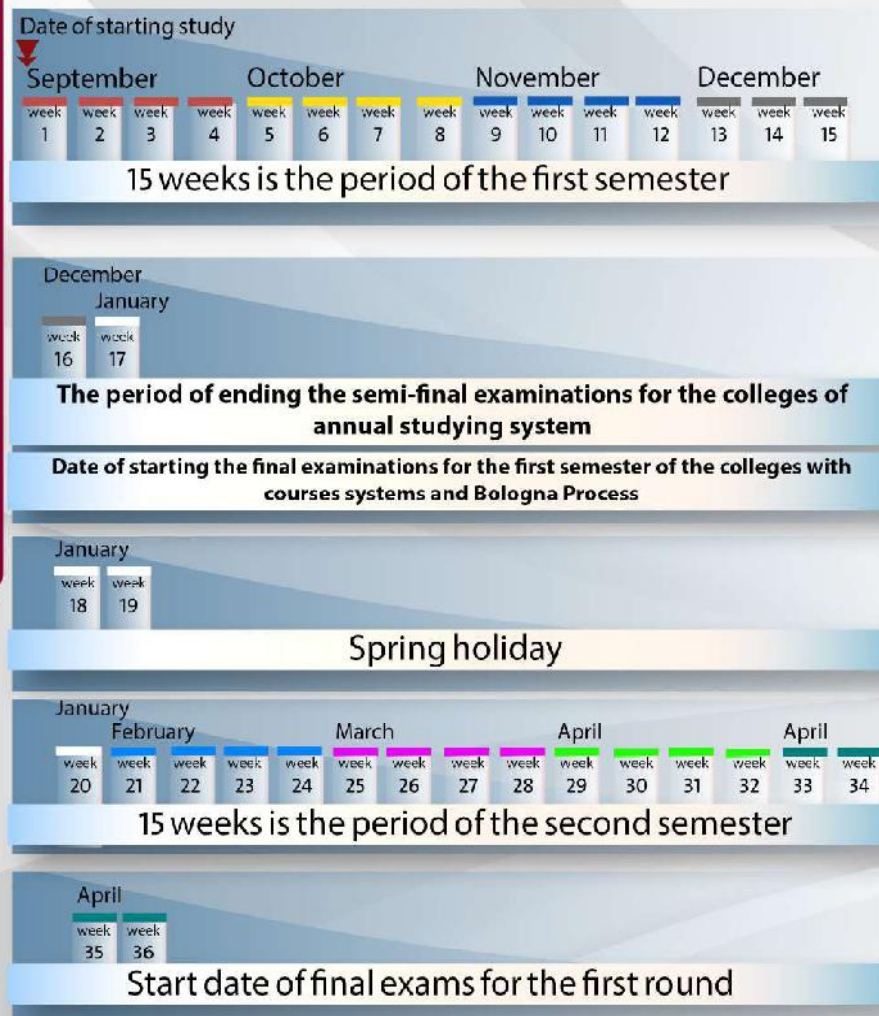
- 1- The system of undergraduate and graduate studies in all Iraqi universities depends on in-person attendance and there is no correspondence
- 2- The course and thesis system is used to study for the Master's degree.
- 3- The system of courses, comprehensive examination and thesis is adopted for doctoral studies.
- 4- There is no research Ph.D.

Third:

a) Undergraduate Admission: General admission requirements for Iraqi colleges (Public/Private) and their academic scores to obtain the undergraduate certificate (bachelor's) and according to the branches of the preparatory school certificate (high school /baccalaureate) or its equivalent.

The admission requirements for applicants to college departments are determined by the nomination committees in each university or college after considering the academic subjects in the certificate obtained by the applicant and according to the corresponding specializations

b) Postgraduate Admission:

- 1- Certificates are equated for applicants who hold bachelor's and Master's degrees in the scientific department concerned with the study, in coordination with the committee formed in each university for the purpose of nomination and acceptance procedures for scholarships within the program.
- 2- A decision is made to address the applicant's scientific background matching by identifying the transferred credits by the department and according to the following.
 - a) The percentage of transferred credits shall not exceed **40%** of the programs of the preparatory year for postgraduate studies in which the applicant will be admitted '. If he/she is applying to study for a Ph.D., the number of transferred credits required shall not exceed (**40%**) of the subjects of doctoral studies for the (bachelor's and Master's) stages in which.
 - b) Reliance on the preparatory year programs and academic materials with a fixed methodology, and consideration is given to the transferred credits between similar specializations in different colleges, and the name of the university from which the applicant graduated, the granting country, or the graduate's sequence upon graduation is not relied upon.
 - c) Besides the requirements of postgraduate studies, the student is required to complete the supplementary requirements specified for him/her related to the deficiency in his/her previous academic achievement for his postgraduate studies or his/her previous study curriculum and to obtain in each subject an average grade at least according to the postgraduate studies grade scale. If he/she fails in this, he/she must retake the exam only once (first and second). These subjects are not included in calculating the average and are included in calculating the number of subjects in the semester.
 - d) The applicant will be informed of the committee's decision regarding conditional acceptance by transit system of the transferred credits and knowing his position regarding the nomination before issuing University admission.

Chapter one/ General Instructions

First: General Instructions to use e-platform:

- The website contains all details and information about universities, official links, ways of communicating with universities and other information that enables the student to learn about the nature of the study within Iraq as well as the cities located in the universities and the programs offered by them and others.
- The application shall be through the creation of an account through the above website which requires permanent e-mail to enable the student to activate the account and communicate with the student in the future.

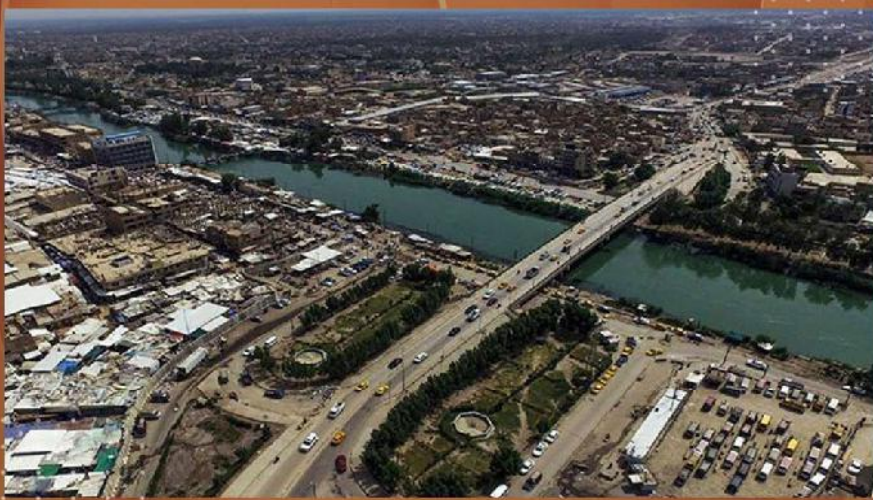
1-Al-Qadisiyah University (Public)

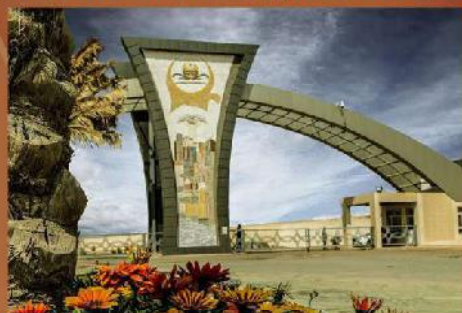

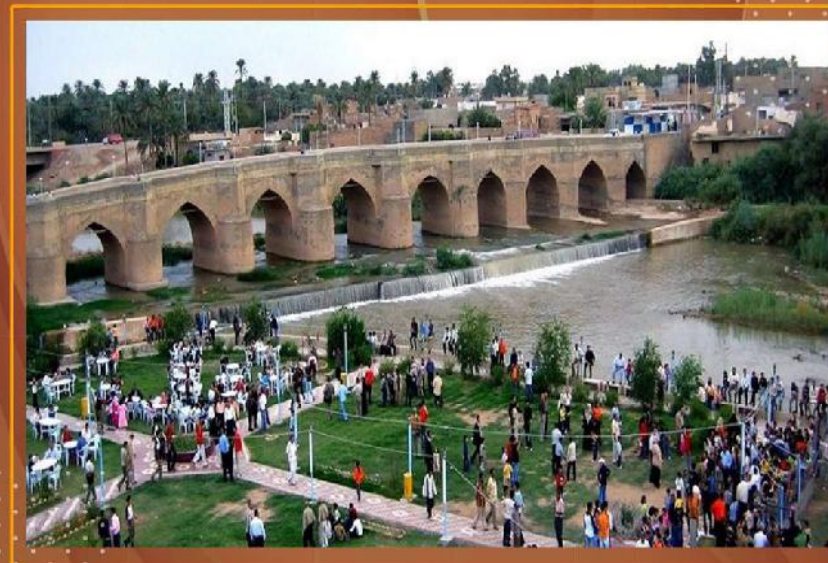
4- University of Hillah (Private)

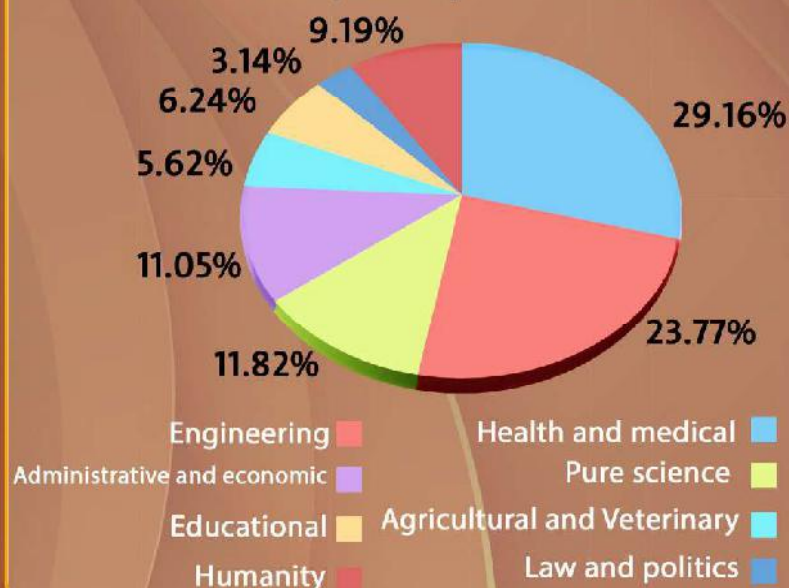

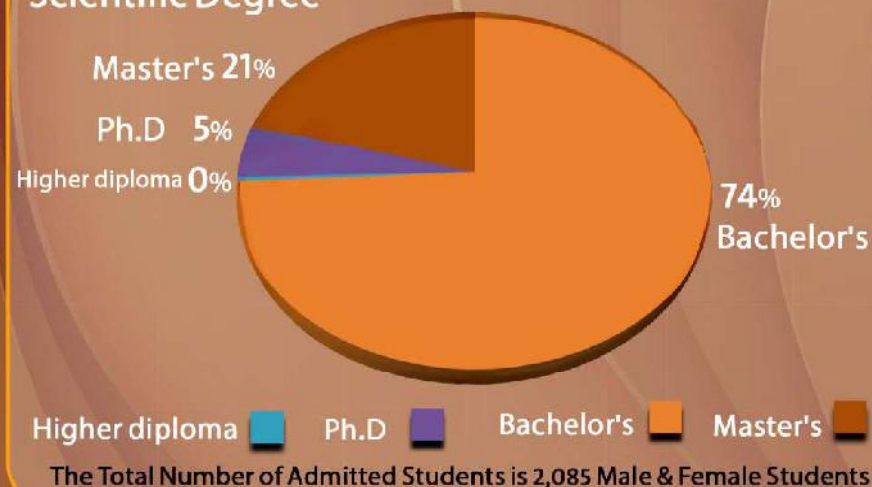

Percentage of Admitted Students According to the Specialty 2024-2025

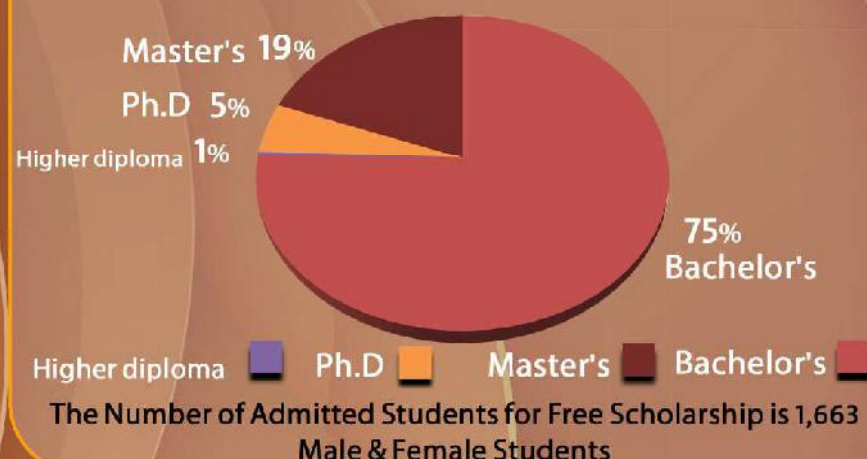

Percentage of Admitted Students According to Scientific Degree

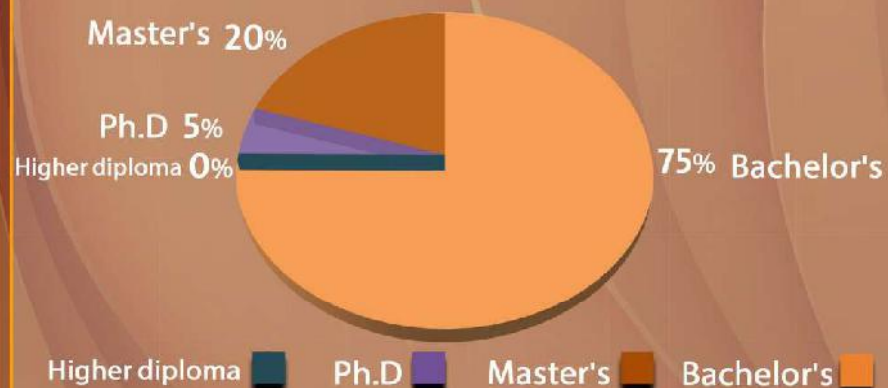


Percentage of Admitted Students in Free Scholarship Channel According to Scientific Degree



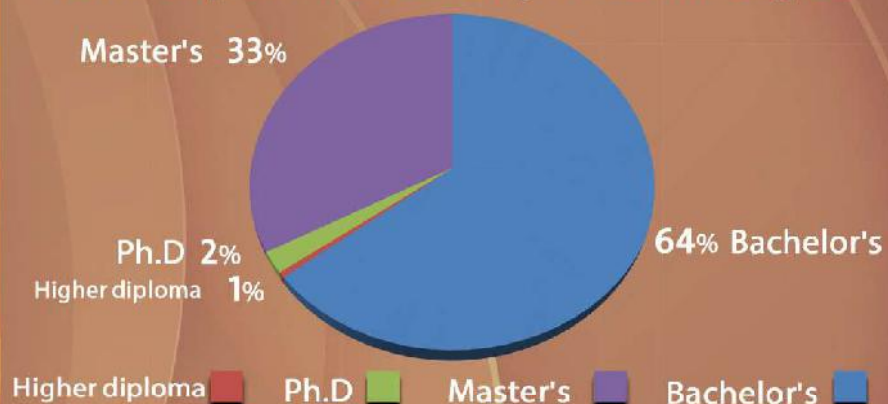

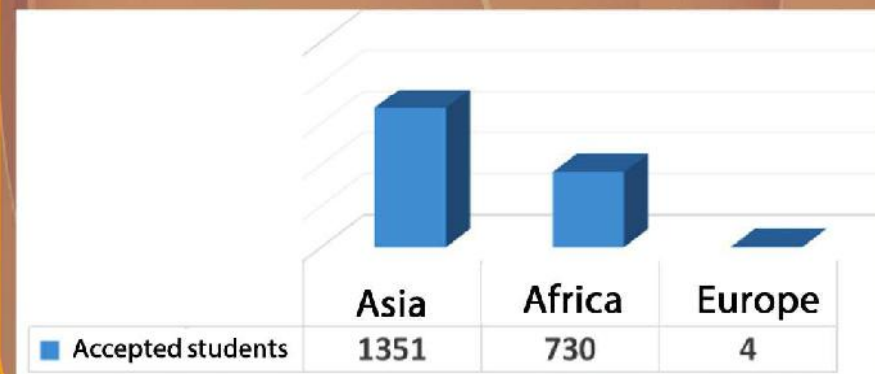
Percentage of Admitted Students in Private Expense Scholarship Channel According to Scientific Degree

Number of Admitted Students According to Continent

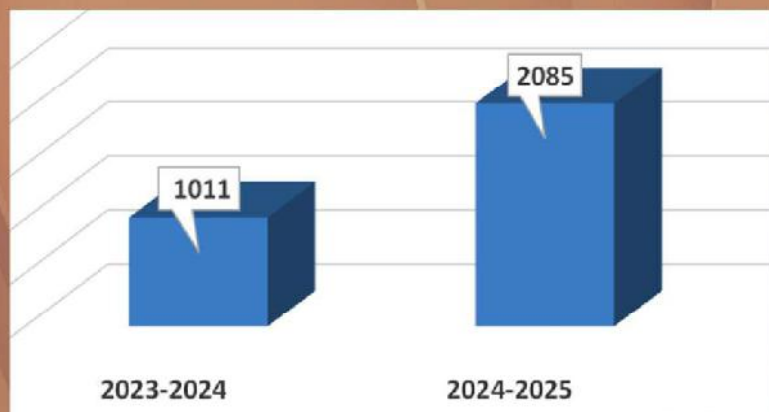


Comparison of the Number of Submitted Students for the Academic Years 2023-2024 & 2024-2025
